We are pleased to provide internet access to our employees, hirers and visitors. You will be provided with the appropriate login credentials for your needs. To ensure a safe, secure, and reliable connection for everyone, anyone using our network must abide by the following

1. Authorized Access & Legal Use

Authorized Access Only: Please only connect to the Wi-Fi network using the credentials provided to you. Do not attempt to guess passwords for other networks, bypass security, connect personal smart devices to internal networks, or access parts of the system you do not have permission for.

No Illegal or Inappropriate Content: Do not access, download, or distribute anything illegal, extremist, or sexually explicit. Please respect that this is a community and church environment.

2. Be Fair with Bandwidth

Don't Hog the Connection: We all share the same internet line. Please avoid excessive downloading, uploading massive files, or running bandwidth-heavy operations (like non-stop high-definition streaming) that slow the internet down for everyone else.

3. No Spam or Malicious Activity

No Spamming: Do not use our network to send out bulk emails, spam, or scam messages.

Keep it Clean: Do not knowingly download, distribute, or spread viruses, malware, or ransomware.
